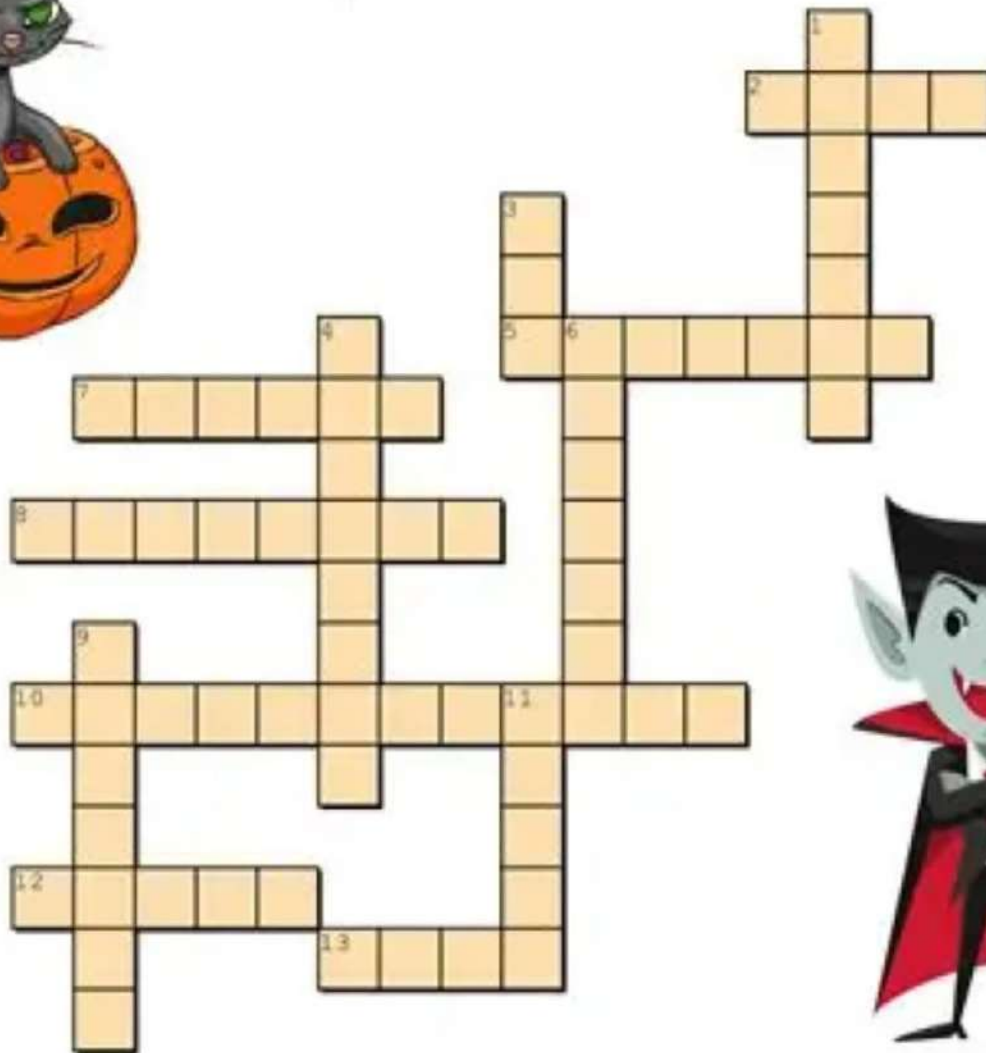
Dental Education

Armed Intruder Training

- Recognizing potential threats and how to respond in a likely fashion.
- “Run, Hide, Fight” principles adapted to a healthcare setting.
- Protecting residents safely during an active threat situation.
- Communication procedures with law enforcement and staff.
- Post-incident support for residents, families and staff.
