## KING AND QUEEN



## ENVIROMENTAL SERVICES:

Environmental Services plays such a vital role in maintain a clean, safe and welcoming environment for everyone in our facility. This dedicated team works diligently behind the scenes to ensure resident rooms, common areas, and workspaces are sanitized, organized, and comfortable. Here are some key tips for environmental services.

- Please DO NOT put anything within 18 inches of the sprinkler heads. This is also including anything within the closet.
- Please DO NOT hang anything on or put anything on sprinkler heads or pipes.
- Please DO NOT clutter the residents' rooms or closets. This imposes a HUGE fall risk for the residents.

## Infection Control:

With the weather fluctuating the way it has been, we wanted to give reminders about infection control and how important it is! Infection control is essential in protecting the health and safety of our residents, staff and visitors within our facility! Through proper hand hygiene, routine cleaning and disinfecting, appropriate use of personal protective equipment (PPE) and carefully monitoring symptoms!
