We are excited for a fun-filled month ahead with activities, celebrations, and opportunities to spend time together.

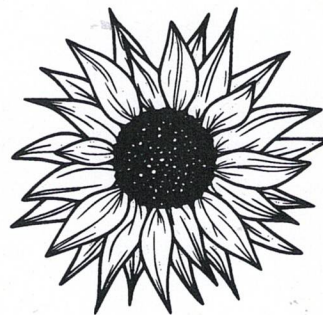

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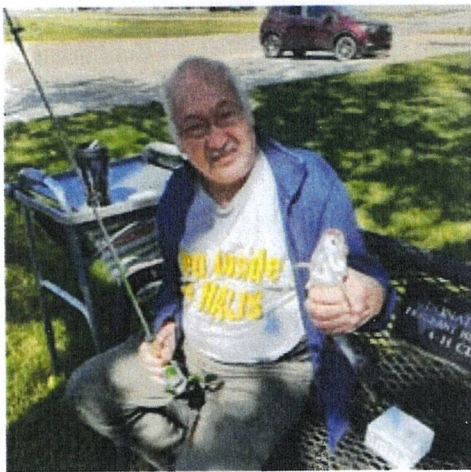

Please remember to label all clothing items with the resident's name to help prevent lost items. Thank you for helping keep closets organized and residents comfortable throughout the summer season!



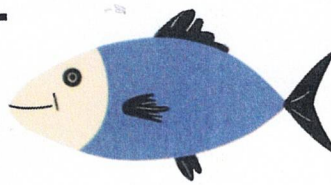

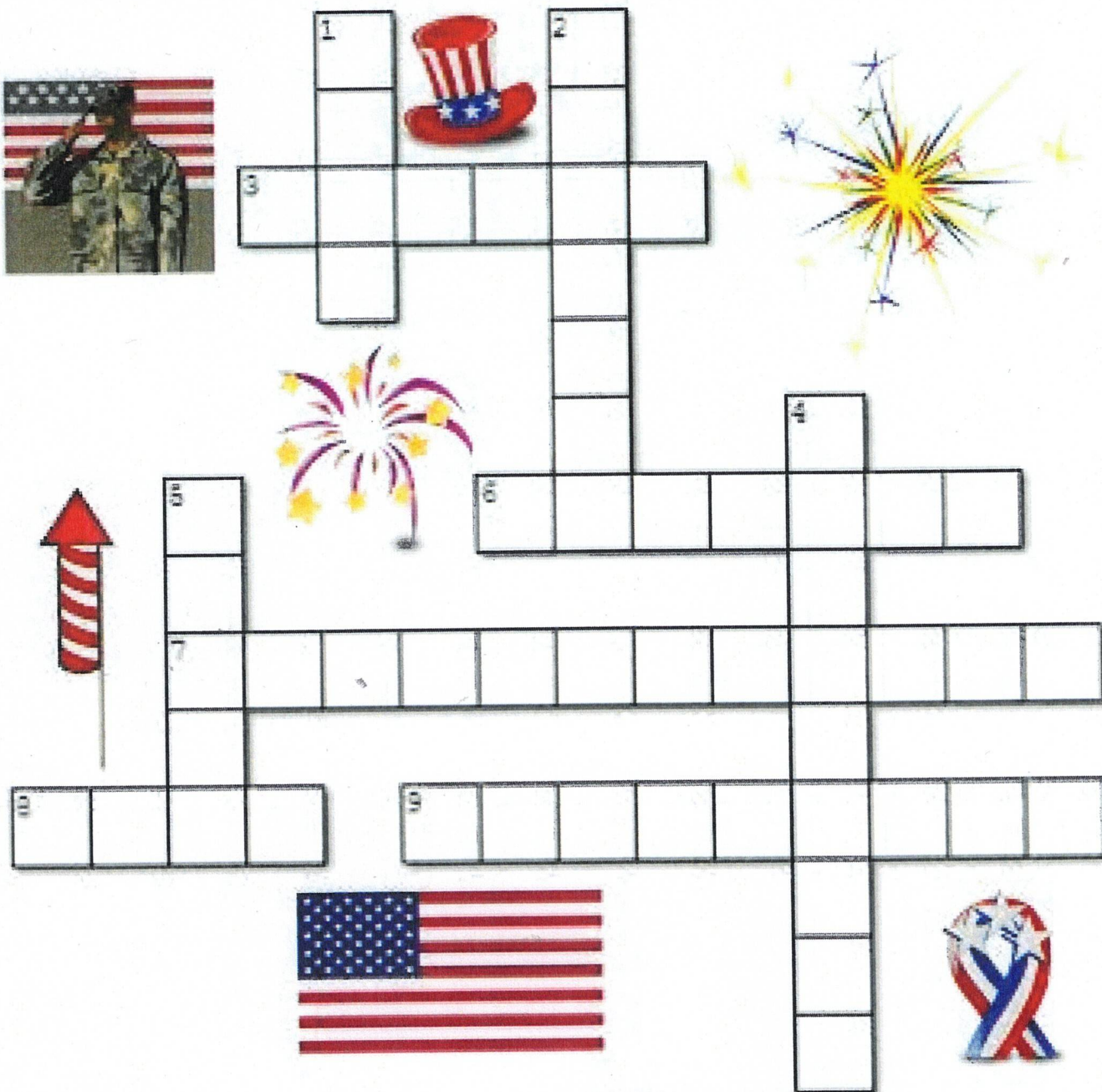
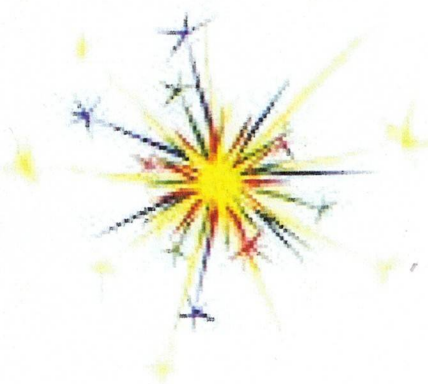
